Environmental Policy

"The Friends of M.V.Freedom are committed to minimising the impact of its activities on the environment".

The policy statement above sets out the following aims to achieve this:-

- 1. To meet the environmental legislation that relates to the operation of M.V Freedom and where possible identify opportunities to adopt best practice over and above the minimum legislative requirements.
- 2. To ensure the Charity manages all potential pollution risks from M.V.Freedom to protect our local waters, including oil, fuel, antifoul and cleaning products.
- 3. To remain alert for the presence of invasive non native species in our local waters.
- 4. To manage all waste generated or collected by MV Freedom through a hierarchy of reduce, re-use and recycle before responsible disposal.
- 5. To treat all sealife in acordance with best practice and the law, and encourage others to do the same.
- 6. To seek sustainable practices when organising and running fundraising and social events.
- 7. To publicise our environmental commitment and encourage sustainable best practice amongst our members and boat passengers.
- 8. To consider the environmental credentials of our suppliers when procuring new products, thereby encouraging other organisations to integrate sustainability into their own operations.
- 9. To include environmental awareness and good practice in our crew training programme.
- 10. To measure our progress and review this environmental policy on an annual basis to ensure continual improvement.
